Mr. Lahey and Randy will be signing bottles of specially-labelled wine from 4:00 to 4:30 pm at Cook St. Village Wines' temporary location, a trailer behind Food Country. "We'll try to provide everyone with a chance to say hello and get an autograph," says Barlow.
